Dear Parent,

You are aware that Hon'ble Supreme Court of India has directed CBSE to re-conduct the AIPMT Examination, 2015 because of the report of use of unfair means during the conduct of this examination on 3rd May, 2015. Accordingly, the re-examination will be conducted on 25.07.2015 (Saturday).

Board is aware that your ward had worked very hard for this examination but because of use of unfair means by some unscrupulous elements, your ward has to once again appear in this examination. Board is also aware that you have put in lots of efforts as well as spent your hard earned money in preparation of your ward for this examination. But because of dishonest intentions of few persons, your efforts and money both has gone waste. Now time has come when all the citizen of the country should stand up against this social evil and support the CBSE in the smooth and fair conduct of this examination.

Tomorrow you could be the proud parent when your ward will clear this examination fairly for getting admission into renowned medical colleges of the country. It is expected from you to kindly ensure the following while your ward is leaving home for appearing in the AIPMT Examination that:

- 1. Your ward will follow all the instructions and maintain the discipline in the examination.
- Your ward will not breach any examination rule.
- 3. Your ward will not use and promote any unfair means activity during the examination.
- In case, your ward finds that any candidate is using unfair means in the examination, the same should immediately be reported to the invigilators on duty.
- Your ward will bring only the following at the examination centre (No photograph will be clicked at the centre):
 - a) Admit Card along with passport size photograph affixed on it;
 - b) One Postcard Size Photograph affixed on the proforma and
 - c) One passport size photograph to be affixed on attendance sheet.
- 6. Your ward will not bring any of the following items at the centre:
 - a) stationery items like textual material (printed or written), bits of papers, Geometry/Pencil Box, Plastic Pouch, Calculator, Pen, Scale, Writing Pad, Pen Drives, Eraser, Calculator, Log Table, Electronic Pen/Scanner etc;
 - b) communication devices like Mobile Phone, Bluetooth, Earphones, Microphone, Pager, Health Band etc;
 - c) other items like Wallet, Goggles, Handbags, Hair Pin, Hair Band, Charm/Tabeez (ताबीज़), Belts, Cap,
 - d) eatable items (opened or packed), water bottle etc;
 - e) ornaments like Ring, Bracelet, Earrings, Nose Pin, Chain/Necklace, Pendants, Badge, Brooch etc;
 - f) Watch/Wrist Watch, Camera etc;
 - g) metallic items and
 - any other item which could be used for unfair means and for hiding communication devices like Mobile,
 Camera, Bluetooth etc.

- 7. Your ward will observe the following dress code while coming for appearing in AIPMT Examination:
 - (a) wear light clothes with half sleeves Shirt/T-Shirt/Kurta not having big buttons, brooch or any badge, flower and Trouser/Salwar etc.
 - (b) will wear open slippers and not the shoes.
- 8. Your ward will cooperate with the staff in frisking at examination centre.
- Your ward will report at allotted examination centre well in advance (i.e. 07.30 09.30 am) to make himf/herself available for compulsory physical frisking.
- No candidate who reports after 09.30 AM shall be allowed to enter in the examination centre. Therefore, kindly ensure that your ward leaves home well in advance considering all factors like traffic, location of the centre, weather conditions etc.

In case, your ward is found disobeying any of the above instructions will not be allowed to enter the examination centre and appear in the examination.

Board has deep faith in the principles observed in your family and thus, confident that you will guide your ward accordingly. I am sure that with your support, CBSE will write a new era in the fair conduct of the examination.
